Ontario Hockey Federation Mandates Throat Protectors for Officials

In the interest of ensuring safe hockey experiences for all Ontario Hockey Federation members, the OHF passed a motion at the September 2010 Board of Directors meeting which mandates that all officials wear BNQ approved throat protectors effective November 15, 2010. The motion reads as follows:

“That throat protection (BNQ) for officials be mandatory by November 15, 2010.”
