WOMAN IN HOCKEY AWARD



AWARD DESCRIPTION

The Woman in Hockey Award honours an individual for their exceptional contribution to the promotion and advancement of female hockey in Ontario.

CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES

ELIGIBILITY

- A nominee may be of any age.
- A nominee must be living.
- A nominee may not win the award twice.

QUALIFICATIONS

- The recipient must be actively involved in promoting female hockey within Ontario. This can include initiatives that encourage female participation, development, and visibility in the sport.
- The individual must demonstrate a significant impact on female hockey through their contributions. This could involve leadership, innovation, or dedication that has made a notable difference in the growth and support of female hockey.
- The award recognizes leadership in one or more of the following areas:
 - Coaching: Contributing to the development and mentorship of female players.
 - Officiating: Promoting and supporting female officials in hockey.
 - Research: Conducting research that supports or enhances the understanding and development of female hockey.
 - Administration: Providing leadership in the management and organization of female hockey programs.
 - Events/Special Projects: Leading or participating in events or projects that promote female hockey.

METHOD OF NOMINATION

- Nomination forms will be distributed by the OHF to each Member and are also available at www.ohf.on.ca.
- OHF Associations who have nominees must send them through their Member. (ALLIANCE, GTHL, NOHA, OHA, OHL, OMHA, OWHA)



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METHOD OF SELECTION

- Each Member will select up to a maximum of one (1) candidate from their organization. **This application will be forwarded to the OHF office, Attention: Scott Stevens prior to September 12, 2025.** Any applications submitted after this date will not be considered.
