AWARD DESCRIPTION

The OHF Officiating Program Award recognizes individuals actively involved in the officiating program, for their contribution to the game, for their officiating skills and for what they put back into amateur hockey within the Branch.

CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES

ELIGIBILITY

- A nominee may be of any age.
- A nominee active in officiating.
- A nominee may not win the award twice.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must have been or be active in amateur hockey.
- Have made an outstanding contribution to amateur hockey.

METHOD OF NOMINATION

- Nomination forms will be distributed by the OHF to each Member and are also available at www.ohf.on.ca.
- OHF Associations who have nominees must send them through their Member. (ALLIANCE, GTHL, NOHA, OHA, OHL, OMHA, OWHA)

METHOD OF SELECTION

Each Member will select up to a maximum of one (1) candidate from their organization. This application will be forwarded to the OHF office, Attention: Scott Stevens prior to September 12, 2025. Any applications submitted after this date will not be considered.
