AWARD DESCRIPTION

The Bill Richmond Award is presented by the Ontario Hockey Federation for outstanding achievement in the area of development of amateur hockey in the Branch.

CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES

ELIGIBILITY

- Candidates require a minimum of five (5) years of service in the area of development with a Member of the OHF.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a Master Course Conductor
- Must be an active Program Instructor
- Must be a major contributor to development programs to a Member of the OHF

METHOD OF NOMINATION

- Nomination forms will be distributed by the OHF to each Member and are also available at www.ohf.on.ca.
- OHF Associations who have nominees must send them through their Member. (ALLIANCE, GTHL, NOHA, OHA, OHL, OMHA, OWHA)

METHOD OF SELECTION

- Each Member will select up to a maximum of two (2) candidates from their organization. **These applications will be forwarded to the OHF office, Attention: Scott Stevens prior to September 12, 2025.** Any applications submitted after this date will not be considered.
